




School Bus Inspections

- An important duty of the Highway Patrol is to conduct annual school bus inspections for the state. From 2011-2013, OSHP performed 138,407 school bus inspections, an average of 46,137 per year. Every school bus in the state must be inspected before the beginning of each school year.

Passing Stopped School Buses

- Motorists approaching a school bus from either direction should remember they are required to stop at least 10 feet back from buses displaying red flashing lights and an extended stop arm. Drivers may not resume driving until the school bus begins moving.
- From 2011-2013, 4,055 drivers* were convicted of failing to stop for a school bus that was loading or dropping off passengers. OSHP troopers wrote 1,321 such citations during that time.

School Bus Crashes

- From 2011-2013, 4,378 crashes involving school buses occurred on Ohio's roadways, an average of 1,459 per year. This includes 7 fatal crashes (7 fatalities) as well as 758 injury crashes (1,699 injuries). None of the 7 killed was on a school bus. However, 62% of those injured were.
