




School Bus Inspections

- Ohio law requires that OSHP conduct school bus inspections for the state. Every bus used to transport pupils is inspected before the beginning of each school year and once during the year. From 2012-2014, OSHP performed 136,765 such inspections, an average of 45,588 per year.

Passing Stopped School Buses

- Motorists approaching a school bus from either direction should remember they are required to stop at least 10 feet back from buses displaying red flashing lights and an extended stop arm. Drivers may not resume driving until the school bus begins moving.
- From 2012-2014, 4,059 drivers* were convicted of failing to stop for a school bus that was loading or dropping off passengers. OSHP troopers wrote 1,446 such citations during that time.

School Bus Crashes

- From 2012-2014, 3,972 traffic crashes involving school buses** occurred in Ohio. Ten of these crashes resulted in 13 fatalities; however, none of those killed were on a school bus. In 2014, 7 fatal bus crashes killed 10 individuals. All 7 crashes happened between September and December.
