




School Bus Inspections

- Ohio law requires that OSHP conduct school bus inspections for the state. Every bus used to transport pupils is inspected before the beginning of each school year and once randomly during the year. From 2013-2015, OSHP performed 132,821 such inspections, an average of 44,274 per year.

Passing Stopped School Buses

- Motorists approaching a school bus from either direction should remember they are required to stop at least 10 feet back from buses displaying red flashing lights and an extended stop arm. Drivers may not resume driving until the school bus begins moving.
- From 2013-2015, 4,043 drivers¹ were convicted of failing to stop for a school bus that was loading or dropping off passengers. OSHP troopers wrote 1,542 such citations during that time.

School Bus Crashes

- From 2013-2015, 3,892 traffic crashes involving school buses² were reported in Ohio. Although no fatal crashes involving school buses happened in 2015, there were 9 such crashes in 2013-14. None of the 12 people killed in these crashes were on a school bus.
