




STATEWIDE REPORTED TRAFFIC FATALITIES 01/01/2009 – 04/19/2009



SIGNIFICANT HIGHWAY PATROL APPREHENSION LOOKING BEYOND THE LICENSE PLATE

On 3/12/09, Trooper Smart stopped a rented 2009 Cadillac Escalade for following too close and turn signal violations on I70 in Preble Co. Numerous criminal indicators were observed and an OSHP canine alerted to the vehicle. A PC search revealed a total of 10 individual gallons of PCP valued at \$3 million hidden in a locked suitcase in the trunk. This was the largest amount of PCP the Patrol has ever seized in a single traffic stop.

On 3/23/09, Trooper Bolen attempted to stop a 1994 Honda Accord that changed lanes without signaling on SR82 in Trumbull Co. The suspect vehicle fled and a short pursuit ensued but was terminated due to traffic congestion. Shortly thereafter, the vehicle crashed. The male driver fled the scene and the female passenger advised that the suspect was armed with a gun. A perimeter was established and the suspect was apprehended by the Howland TPD Chief. A search party consisting of Fowler TPD, Howland TPD, and OSHP was assembled and the weapon was recovered. Female passenger advised that she was kidnapped and raped by the suspect in Youngstown, OH. It is believed that the suspect was on the way to Niles, OH to confront the victim's brother.



2008 OVI Statistics²

CRASHES INVOLVING AT-FAULT IMPAIRED DRIVERS

- There were 15,318 OVI-related crashes on Ohio roads in 2008, resulting in 466 deaths and 9,315 injuries.
- Slightly less than half (45%) of at-fault drivers in OVI crashes were between 21 and 35 years of age; an additional 21% were between 36 and 45 years of age. Drivers age 16 to 20 were at fault in ten percent (10%) of OVI crashes. Fifty-nine percent (59%) of all OVI crashes in 2008 were speed-related.

OVI ARRESTS by OSHP

- OSHP troopers arrested a total of 25,512 impaired drivers in 2008. Of these, nearly one-quarter (5,791/23%) included safety belt violations; one in five (4,979/20%) included speeding violations; and 4,849 (19%) involved violations for driving without a valid driver license.
- Impaired driving arrests ranged by county. Franklin County had the most (1,441), followed by Butler (1,132), Lucas (985), and Montgomery (876).
- Two-thirds (67%) of OVI arrests occurred between midnight and 4:00 a.m.; More than half (54%) of all OVI arrests were made between 5:00 p.m. Friday and 5:00 a.m. Sunday.

2009 OVI Statistics

- There have been 2,383 reported crashes involving impaired drivers thus far in 2009, including 38 fatal crashes (49 total deaths) and 975 injury crashes (1,367 total injuries).
- From 01/01/2009 to 04/21/2009, OSHP officers have made 7,502 impaired driving arrests.
