The Ohio State Highway Patrol is scheduled for an on-site assessment to achieve re-accreditation status by verifying that we meet professional standards, identified by the Commission on Accreditation for Law Enforcement Agencies (CALEA). A national team of assessors from the Commission on Accreditation for Law Enforcement Agencies will arrive on July 19, 2008 to examine all aspects of the Department's policies and procedures, management, operations, and support services. The team consists of team leader Retired Lt. Colonel Robert T. Johnson, Major Mark Keel of the South Carolina Law Enforcement Division and Sergeant Gerry Mouzon of the North Carolina Highway Patrol.

As a part of the on-site assessment, we welcome you to offer your comments at a public call-in session at 1-866-931-6448 (toll free). The assessment team will take comments from 1-5 p.m., on July 21, 2008. Telephone comments are generally limited to ten minutes and must address the agency's ability to comply with CALEA standards.
