Cincinnati woman arrested for Illegal Drug Conveyance at Warren Correctional Institution

LEBANON – A Cincinnati woman will appear in Lebanon Municipal Court Monday after Ohio State Highway Patrol troopers arrested her Saturday for attempting to convey drugs into Warren Correctional Institution.

Troopers charged Sarah Waynick, 28, with attempting to convey drugs onto the grounds of a detention facility, a third-degree felony and possession of criminal tools, a fifth-degree felony.

Troopers and Department of Rehabilitation and Correction investigators obtained information that Waynick would attempt to convey drugs to her boyfriend during a scheduled visit. Waynick was arrested after a consent search revealed 19 balloons containing a total of 17 grams of marijuana concealed on her person.

Waynick was incarcerated in the Warren County jail. If convicted, she could face up to five years in prison and a \$13,250 fine.

The Ohio State Highway Patrol investigates criminal activity on state owned and leased property.
