### **Steubenville woman arrested for Illegal Drug Conveyance**

St. Clairsville - A Steubenville woman is facing felony charges after troopers arrested her today for attempting to convey drugs into the Belmont Correctional Institution.

Ohio State Highway Patrol troopers charged Jamie Lin Moffat, 27, with attempting to convey drugs onto the grounds of a detention facility, a third-degree felony, and driving with a suspended license, a first-degree misdemeanor.

Moffat was arrested for driving with a suspended license while entering the grounds of the Belmont Correctional Institution. Investigation by troopers and the Department of Rehabilitation and Correction led them to believe that she would attempt to convey drugs onto the grounds of the facility during a scheduled visit today. Moffat was transported to the Belmont County Jail for incarceration. During a search four balloons of marijuana were found on her person.

Moffat remains incarcerated in the Belmont County Jail. If convicted, she could face up to five years in prison and a \$10,000 fine.
