- Tour and dinner at the [OSU Shoe](#): Ohio Stadium is one of the most recognizable landmarks in all of sports. Built in 1922 and refurbished in 2001, the horseshoe-shaped stadium is a monument to college football. With its present seating capacity of 104,944, Ohio Stadium is the fourth largest on-campus facility in the nation.



- [Ohio Village](#): At the Ohio History Connection guest get an insider's look at Ohio life in the 1890s. Visitors can stand on the stage of Town Hall and give a speech, visit with Ohio Village residents, star in their own 1890s photo shoot and play old fashioned games on the Pavilion & Village Green. Ohio Village is the home field of the Ohio Village Muffins, a vintage base ball (yes, two words) club that plays by the rules of the 1860s.
